You must already hold full current GMC registration with license to practice and hold MRCOG Part 1 or equivalent. As important are an empathetic approach with patients and excellent communication skills with team members in all disciplines. Previous experience in fertility investigations and ultrasound scanning skills would be advantageous.

You will join one of the most prestigious units in the UK based at our flagship clinic near Cambridge with regular travel to our Norwich clinic and occasional presence required to support our Wickford clinic in Essex.

This is initially a two-year post with a possibility of becoming permanent and/or extension. You must have the right to work in the UK and have excellent English language skills.
